***Future tax liabilities/assets fluctuate depending on the realized and unrealized gains/losses of the investment portfolio on the valuation day. Where the balance is a future tax asset, it represents a tax benefit. Urbana's policy is to ensure that the tax asset recognized is consistent with the amount that can be recognized in accordance with Canadian Generally Accepted Accounting Principles.
