Urbana's policy with respect to recording a tax benefit is to review and determine the amount of such tax benefit to be recorded on a regular basis based on a number of factors, including historical income, taxes paid, market conditions and likelihood of the recovery of the tax balance. Urbana's policy is to ensure that the tax asset recognized is consistent with the amount that can be recognized in accordance with Canadian Generally Accepted Accounting Principles.
